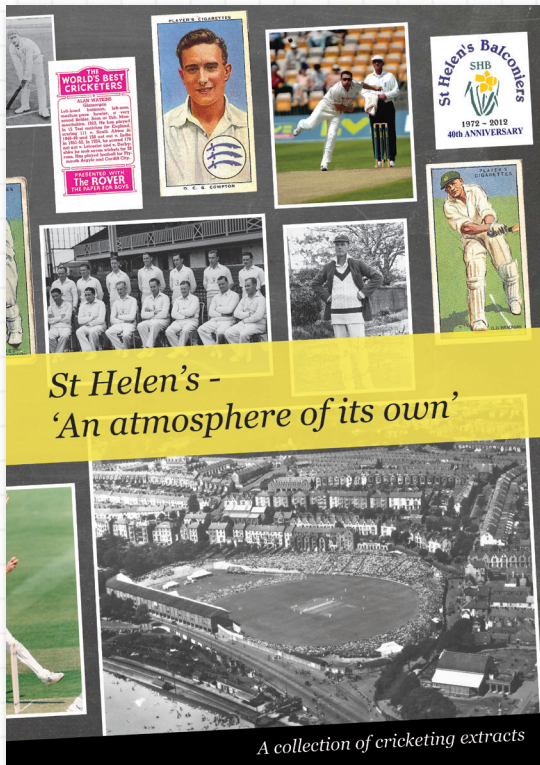

As part of their 40th Anniversary celebrations, St. Helen's Balconiers have produced a commemorative book of cricketing extracts
