Tour 1: *Leicestershire CCC at Leicester*. We will be staying at the Travelodge Leicester Central. We stayed at this hotel for the first-time last year, and we were pleased with the service. The hotel is centrally located with ample choices of eating places close-by.

Tour 2: *Sussex CCC at Hove.* Unfortunately, we failed to get to Hove last year being the last away game of the season, there was not enough interest to make the trip worthwhile. The situation is a lot different this year with two gifted Australian batters Steve Smith and Marnus Labuschagne in opposition. Hotels at Brighton have become too expensive hence the reason why we have chosen the Travelodge on the sea front at Worthing. This is the only 4-night stay trip this season. I have made a commitment this season that the coach would stay until the end of the game, so if the Sussex match continued to close of play on the final day, it would be too late to drive home hence the reason we will go home after breakfast on Monday.

Due to unforeseen circumstances and the fact that we had to cancel last year's trip to Hove as a result we had to fight to recover our deposit. We just managed to retrieve our deposit but at a cost of having to pay this season's balance in full by 23rd March while the terms with the other three Travelodge Hotels is payment 28 days before arrival.
